

Renting RVS and Campers

Things to consider:

- If you can find a rental near Bakersfield, you can drive your car there and pick up the RV/camper and spend a lot less on gas (and less time driving the RV!)
- There are many types of campers and RVs- most people will probably want something 24 feet or smaller (in an RV)
- Start investigating ASAP- as these campers and RVs book up really fast (and you want to do it before January if possible)
